Hire fees

For any groups external to the Carlisle Vineyard Church community a host fee will be applied to your booking. To use the sound and visual systems in the Upper Room you will be required to pay an additional cost for an AV technician. There is also an option to include tea/coffee, please refer to the table for a breakdown of costs:

Rooms and resources

Ground floor:

★ The Mixing Room - This is our large downstairs space. Ideal for social gatherings, or groups up to 50.

Upstairs:

The Upper Room - Large upstairs venue, suitable for conference style meetings of up to 200 people maximum. Minimum of 50 guests is required to use this space. There is an additional small glass-walled room attached to The Upper Room which provides ideal breakout space.

Resources:

There are multiple resources that you can make use of during your booking. We ask that you request these resources as part of your booking so that we can ensure all facilities are stocked and in working order for your event. If you have not requested the use of a resource with your booking, we will expect that those facilities are not used during your event.

- Sound & visual This includes use of the sound system and projector screens. To use the sounds and visual systems in the Upper Room you will be required to pay an additional cost for an AV technician.
- ₭ Kitchen upstairs & downstairs you can book the use of the kitchen which includes
 tea and coffee making facilities. Any food or drink required for your event will need to be
 provided by yourselves. If you wish to bring food to the venue prior to your event, please
 discuss with a member of staff and make sure all your items are clearly labelled.
- ₹ Tea & Coffee you are welcome to add on to your booking tea/coffee to be served to your guests. This will come at an additional cost of £1 per person per drink. Please specify in your booking how many drinks you would like to purchase.
